#### Why in News?

- According to Annual Waterfowl Estimation exercise 2020 The population of Flagship Species ,Bar-headed Goose have shown 68% increase from last year (2018-19) in Pong lake.
- This year Annual Waterfowl Estimation exercise was divided in two parts, first day on 30th Jan 2020 was for pre-count discussions & planning and actual count was carried out on 31th Jan.
   2020 for monitoring the numerical size of bird's population during the year 2019-20 in Pong Dam Wetland.

Birds of Himachal Pradesh, Himachal Bird Club, International Wetland, Wildlife Institute Of India(WII), Dharamshala Bird Club and many wildlife enthusiasts, bird watchers, volunteers along with officials & officers from H.P.Forest Department, participated in this mega exercise.

 A new Education Block would be opened at Khundian in Kangra district to facilitate the people and students of the area.

## Rs 3184 crore for power sector

- Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur has expressed gratitude towards Government of India for recommending a financing facility worth Rs 3184 crore through World Bank for the project namely Himachal Hydro Power and Renewable Power Sector Development Project.
- The program was accepted by Department of Economic Affairs, (DEA), Ministry of Finance, Gol today in 104th meeting of its Screening Committee and recommended to World Bank for financing.
- This financing would come in the pattern of 90 percent grant and 10 percent loan to Government of Himachal Pradesh.
- The project aims at holistic development of power sector of the state through investment in all three segments of power sector i.e. **Generation, Transmission and Distribution**
- On generation part a funding of Rs 1600 crore will come to the ongoing Shongtong Karchham HEP 450 MW.
- Transmission part funding amounting to Rs 534.72 crore would come for strengthening Extra High Voltage transmission (EHV) network in different parts of the state
- Distribution system will get a funding of Rs 937 crore and would be used towards automation and strengthening of distribution network in 13 different towns of Himachal namely Solan, Baddi, Nalagarh, Nahan, Poanta Sahib, Mandi, Sundernagar, Bilaspur, Kullu, Manali, Una, Parwanoo and Hamirpur..

- A capacity building component amounting to Rs 112 crore would flow to all power utilities and
  Directorate of Energy for establishment of facilities and development of capacities for efficient
  management of complex power system by all the utilities together.
- Expertise of advance power markets of the World would be brought in by World Bank to improve the capabilities of energy sector utilities to maximize the revenue earned by the state from sale of energy through renewable balancing capacity.
- This would also enable the uptake of renewable solar power in the state and facilitate the development of solar sector in the state.
- **Integrated development of power sector** of the state is envisaged by complementing different activities of generation, transmission and distribution.

## H.P. got Rs. 443.18 crore under Samagra Shiksha

- Centre Government has released a total of Rs. 443.18 crore to Himachal Pradesh under
   Samagra Shiksha till date for overall development of education sector in the state.
- The amount has been released by Union Ministry of Human Resource Development for provision of free uniform to 4,59,890 students, free text books to 2,98,203 students, composite school grant to 15,414 schools, setting up libraries in 15,399 Schools, ICT and digital initiatives in 55 schools.
- The amount released would be utilised for imparting special training to 5,357 out of school children, running of 13 Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalays, self defence training to girls in 4707 schools, 92 additional classrooms in elementary schools, ramps and handrails in 811 schools, solar panels in 19 schools, electrification in 308 schools.

## **About Samagra Shiksha scheme**

- The Union Budget, 2018-19, has proposed to treat school education holistically without segmentation from pre-nursery to Class 12.
- Samagra Shiksha an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from
  pre-school to class 12 has been, therefore, prepared with the broader goal of improving school
  effectiveness measured in terms of equal opportunities for schooling and equitable learning
  outcomes.

- It subsumes the three erstwhile Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (TE).
- The vision of the Scheme is to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education from pre-school to senior secondary stage in accordance with the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) for Education.

#### Himachali Pahari cow gets recognition at National level

- Himachali Pahari Cow has been officially registered and named as 'Himachali Pahari' cow and this breed has now been included in the category of other indigenous breeds like Sahiwal, Red Sindhi, Gir.
- This breed has been included in the list of recognised breeds of the country by **National Bureau** of **Animal Genetic Resources.**
- in order to include this breed amongst recognised category Animal Husbandry Department has
  compiled the specialities and traits of the cow and presented the data to National Bureau of
  Animal Genetic Resources. After two years concerted efforts the breed has now been
  registered and included in the category of recognised breeds at National level.
- At present the strength of Himachali Pahari cow is estimated to be between **7.50 to 8.00 lakhs** and this cow is mainly found in **Chamba, Mandi, Kullu, Kangra, Sirmaur, Lahaul-Spiti districts**.
- With the registration of this breed, **now funds for their promotion and conservation** would be received from the Government of India.
- Apart from this, the Bureau has also recognized the special breed of buffalo found in the state, which has been named as Gaujari. This breed of buffalo is found mainly in Chamba and Kangra districts

- Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur today released a lyrical CD, 'Pulwama Shradhanjli' a tribute to the Pulwama martyrs, written by Sanjiv Mahajan of Nagrota Surian in Kangra district.
- The music has been composed by Mohan Dutt Sharma where as Pyar Chand has given his melodious voice

## Instructions issued to streamline the mining activities in state

- As per the instructions Mining Officers would ensure that all the existing permitted dumps of minor minerals of mining lease holders be removed and relocated at least at a distance of one kilometre away from the mining lease sites by 25th March 2020.
- Further all the new dumps should only be allowed atleast 1 km. away from mining lease areas and it would be ensured that sign boards on such dumps indicating the name of lessee, name of mining lease, its areas and the period of mining lease are placed.

- If cases of illegal mining by using mechanical excavators like JCB and pocklane etc are noticed then FIR would be lodged against JCB owner and the user/driver and JCB/mechanical excavator should be impounded.
- If any mining lessee is found engaged in unauthorised mining or unscientific mining by using
  mechanical excavators like JCB, Pocklane, etc in violation of terms and condition of mining lease
  deed as well as the approved mining plan, the concerned Mining Officer shall immediately lodge
  FIR and impound the mechanical excavator and immediately suspend the mining activities and
  recommend the case for termination of mining lease to the competent authority instead of
  merely compounding the offence.
- In cases, the vehicles are caught carrying illegal mining material, the Mining Officer concerned shall write to the concerned RTO for cancellation of registration of such vehicles. No transit permit would be given to vehicles which are found engaged in illegal transportation of mining material repeatedly.
- The Mining Officers would take stringent action against the lessee who is involved in overloading by suspension of lease and take up the matter with the concerned RTO for taking action against such vehicles with extended bodies under their respective Act or Rule.
- No transit permit would be issued to vehicles found to be having extended bodies.
- Mining Officers would issue roster for Mining Guards /Assistant Mining Inspectors/ Mining Inspectors to inspect the vulnerable areas covering the river bed as well as terrain in stretch wise manner for utilizing services of field staff effectively and regular inspection are to be ensured.
- Mining Officer would ensure that all the mining lease areas have properly erected boundary
  pillars to clearly depict the lease boundary. In case, the lessee does not erect the boundary
  pillars, the mining activities be suspended forthwith.
- All the Mining Officers are directed to ensure immediate implementation of these instructions. Any laxity in failure to do so would be viewed seriously and invite disciplinary action.
- State Geologist would prepare a format accordingly in which the Mining Officers would submit monthly report to Director, Industries, Himachal Pradesh. He said that strict monitoring of action taken by Mining Officers to implement this plan of action would be done by Director Industries and State Geologist.
- Additional instructions are being issued separately to all the Deputy Commissioners and Superintendents of Police for ensuring prevention of illegal mining and scientific and systematic mining of Minor Minerals in the State.
